The South East Texas Regional Planning Commission (SETRPC) will be providing assistance to low-income residents of Orange County. Households must be at or below 125% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL). Eligibility will be determined at screening.

- ✓ Proof of income received within the last (30) days for each household member 18 years of age or older (paystubs, award letters, etc.)
- ✓ Valid Orange County Address Picture ID (If no ID available; FEMA registration numbers will be accepted.)
